

## EAST OF SCOTLAND KART CLUB (EST.2003) LTD

## MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION/RENEWAL 2019

Membership fees were set at the Annual General Meeting held in December 2018.  
Memberships are valid from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019.

Below are the club’s rules governing the use of the track by members – please obey them and ask that other members at the track to do so too.

- 1) Outside of controlled practice on race weekends and during the race programme, the track may only be used by **MEMBERS** of East of Scotland Kart Club. Membership only applies to whoever is named on your membership form and holds a valid membership card. If a person is found to be using the track who is not a member, the person who allowed them on shall be automatically banned.
- 2) All drivers using the track must wear full safety equipment, i.e. overall, crash helmet, gloves and boots providing ankle protection. Section U13.
- 3) Karts must comply with the current RAC MSA technical regulations – Section U16 of the competitor’s year book. Tyres must be the correct make for that class.
- 4) Drivers **MUST ONLY EXIT** via the exit (Pit) lane, i.e. they must **NOT** exit the track via the dummy grid.
- 5) Drivers must drive slowly and must stop before the end of the exit lane which is marked by a line and a STOP sign. They must **NOT** drive through the Pit area to the dummy grid.
- 6) The track must only be driven in the normal track direction, i.e. clockwise.
- 7) Practice sessions should be run as follows: - cadets, junior, seniors and gear box, with **NO MIXING OF CLASSES**.
- 8) Track users must not drive karts out of their class, i.e. Cadets may not drive junior karts & juniors may not drive senior karts.
- 9) Drivers must not practice unless there is at least one other person present over 16 years of age and are strongly recommended to have a mobile phone with them to call for help if needed.
- 10) If you are involved in an accident on ESKC premises that requires treatment, you must contact a committee member of the club at your earliest opportunity.
- 11) Drivers are required to lock the gate after entry and exit. They are also required to inspect the track, pit lane and dummy grid for obstructions and displaced tyre walls prior to using the track. I, as the main member agree to be bound by the rules (one to eleven) above.
- 12) **AGE LIMIT: 6 YEARS AND OVER**

I will also be responsible for others in my membership obeying the same rules (1 to 12) above while using the ESKC track.

The first membership is £160 regardless of age. Any additional members 18 years old or over is £160.  
Additional members that are under 18 years old must be either Son/Daughter, Brother/Sister of the first member.
